




A Pohjola Route Tour: Summer in the Arctic Archipelago

5D4N Oulu – Hailuoto – Raahe – Kalajoki, Finland






Pohjola route

DAY 1

- Summer night




Activity: Nightless night canoeing in the river estuary (3h)

This night canoeing trip by Indian canoes gives you the opportunity to explore the city of Oulu and its surroundings seen from the waters. Along the canoeing route you may be surprised at the wonders of the wilderness and how close they really are to the city.

We paddle comfortably at a slow pace. The length of the trip is about 2-5 km. Our experienced and well-trained guide will take care of your safety on this trip.





DAY 2

Day Trip to Hailuoto Island (8,5 hrs)

Hailuoto is the largest island in the Bothnian Bay with only 1000 inhabitants.

The journey to Hailuoto includes a 30-minute ferry ride.


Our Hailuoto guide is with the group throughout the day, sharing in-depth information about the island and its history, culture and attractions.


The white city of the North

Return to Oulu and dinner at the hotel.

DAY 3

Oulu – Raaha - Kalajoki

After an hour's drive south from Oulu we stop at Raaha, where we will have a guided tour in Old Raaha – one of the best-preserved 19th century wooden towns in Finland.

The late 19th century was a time of prosperity for the city. Raaha was Finland's largest shipowner city and most of its inhabitants earned their living from shipping.

Even today, the history is vividly present, and the city and its people are full of stories from the heyday of the sailing era.



Trade House of Lang, Old Raahe

See and experience the 19th century Raahe!

The Trade House of Lang is a 19th century style café, a restaurant, a shop and a boutique hotel all in one – all telling the history of the old trade house during the tallship era.

We enjoy an experiential lunch in a historic setting including a 30-minute introduction by a historical figure and cake dessert.




Kalajoki Sand Dunes

After an hour's drive south from Raahе we arrive in Kalajoen Hiekkasärkät resort, also known as Kalajoki Sand Dunes.

Kalajoki Sand Dunes were an excursion destination for the local population at least as early as the 1890s.

Kalajoki Sand Dunes is a large area of sand dunes and shores about three and a half kilometers long.

Today, it is one of Finland's most popular holiday destinations.

DAY 4

Day Trip to Maakalla Island by Sailing Boat (4,5 hrs)

Maakalla is a unique island roughly 18 km off the coast.

It forms an autonomous region with dozens of fishermen's huts, a beautiful wooden church and a fishing museum.

A sailing trip to Maakalla on the traditional vessel Ansio is an experience to remember!

The trip lasts 4.5 hours and includes a salmon soup lunch on board.

In case of too strong wind for the sailing trip, we organize as an alternative program a guided cultural tour in Kalajoki area.


